International cooperation

January 2026 :

The AIST for its seminar brought together nearly 40 delegates in Paris around the green public order.

The exchanges focussed on the integration of sustainability in public policies and tools to support actors.

This event favoured the sharing of experiences and the emergence of concrete solutions on an international scale.

Each year, the AIST symposium addresses key themes of public management, adapted to the challenges and context of the moment.
